

HEALTH/HUMAN SERVICES

Cosmetology (12.0400.10)
Prerequisite: Career Exploration

Grades: 10, 11
Duration: 1 year

This program introduces students to careers in Cosmetology by preparing them to apply academic, employability and basic technical knowledge and skills associated with cosmetologists, barbers, nail technicians, hair stylists, makeup artists, aestheticians and wig stylist. Topics to be covered in this course will prepare students for the higher-level courses where client work will be expected. SkillsUSA participation is encouraged.

Beauty School I (12.0400.20)
Prerequisite: Cosmetology

Grades: 11th, 12th
Duration: 1 year (3 hr-block)

This program provides an excellent opportunity in obtaining direct employment after graduation or a supplemental income while pursuing an advanced education opportunity. The course prepare students to care for and beautify hair, care for complexions, perform manicures, and sell cosmetics in commercial establishments or independently. Includes instruction in hygiene sanitation, customer relations and salon management, and provides training in becoming eligible for the Arizona State Board of Cosmetology Exam. Arizona State Board of Cosmetology requires students to have a 2.0 GPA, two years of successful completion of English classes, and be at least 16 years of age for enrollment into a beauty school in the state of Arizona. Training programs available include Cosmetology (1600 hrs), Aesthetician (600 hrs), or Nail Technology (600 hrs). After-school program will help students in obtaining additional training hours and skills that will allow them to work towards completing their chosen training program hours. Dual Enrollment through Northland Pioneer College is also offered in this course upon successful completion of the ASSET Reading Test. SkillsUSA membership is required.

Beauty School II (12.0400.75)
Prerequisite: Beauty School I

Grades: 12th
Duration: 1 year (2 hr-block)

Course Description: This program is a continuation of the students' chosen Beauty School training program, where students will already be enrolled in the Beauty School, based on the Arizona State Board of Cosmetology requirements. The course prepare students in obtaining clinical experience in more advanced techniques that requires using chemicals, such as permanent waving, chemical hair relaxing, hair coloring, and application of acrylic nails. Dual Enrollment through Northland Pioneer College is also offered in this course upon successful completion of all prerequisite classes with a "C" average in Beauty School I. After-school program will help students in completing their training hours and skills that will allow them to prepare for their licensure exam at the Arizona State Board of Cosmetology. Upon passing the Theory and Practical Exams, students will obtain their license to work in a salon within the state of Arizona. SkillsUSA membership is required.
